AFS Student Chapter at Virginia Tech VTFIRE

 has not happened since Pre-Covid.



- The FEF certification visit took place at Virginia Tech on 2/22. From early indications, VTFIRE
 has passed its certification, but we do not know how long the certification will be for.
- Main concern for the department is the lack of enrollment in Material Science and Engineering.
 - Before Covid, VTFIRE was averaging 100 students in metal casting related classes.
 Currently, it is averaging 55 students.
- Ashley Lacy and Nikki Powell received the AFS Piedmont Scholarship. Ashley will intern at Tyler Union, and Nikki will intern at Waupaca over the summer.


